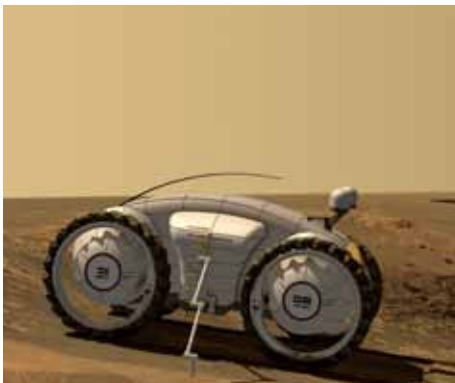


DLD Conference
